

TERMS OF USE FOR VISITORS AND ATTENDEES

The Terms of Use apply to the SupplyCon organized by Procurement and Supply Institute of Asia (PASIA) Event that you may visit or attend face-to-face or by remote communication over the Internet. Please review these terms carefully. By your registration with the series, you agree to these Terms of Use that apply to all the exhibits or events, physical and virtual. If you do not agree to these Terms of Use, please do not register for the series.

Procurement and Supply Institute of Asia (PASIA) (or "The Organizer") may update and/or modify the Terms of Use at any time, with or without notice to you. Any and all modifications shall be applicable prospectively upon publication in the website of the organizer at <https://pasia.org/> You are encouraged to review the terms of service or privacy policies offered by the virtual event sponsor, as they may differ. The Organizer is not responsible for or liable to you for the policies of the virtual event sponsor. The Organizer may terminate any or all parts of the virtual event or access at any time, with or without notice to you.

You may access the virtual event, or visit the physical exhibit, provided that you:

- create a user account with accurate registration information and keep your access link secure.
- are over the age of 18 or use the website under the consent and supervision of a parent or guardian.
- do not initiate or participate in any of the activities that are prohibited, illegal, harmful, or interfere with anyone's use of the virtual or physical event, including the sending of e-mail or instant messaging spam, or engage in vexatious conduct.
- comply with all the applicable laws and ordinances and these Terms of Use.

By registering for the series, your contact information including name and email will be visible to other attendees as you interact in chat rooms, and will be shared with the specific exhibitor/sponsor of the booths that you visit. Your information will also be used for post event marketing.

Appropriate Conduct

The series of events will provide an ideal opportunity to exchange information, participate in education sessions, network, and buy and sell new products and services. The Organizer is committed to providing a friendly, safe, and welcoming environment for all, regardless of gender, sexual orientation, disability, race, ethnicity, religion, or national origin. We expect all attendees, journalists, speakers, staff, volunteers, organizers, venue staff, vendors, and exhibitors to help us ensure a safe and positive experience for everyone. The guidelines for appropriate behavior and conduct at this virtual event are listed below. Also included are the expectations for participant behavior, as well as the consequences for unacceptable behavior.

- Be considerate, respectful, and collaborative.
- Refrain from demeaning, discriminatory, or harassing behavior or speech.
- Alert The Organizer if you notice a dangerous, vexatious, or harassing situation, or someone in distress.

Content & Trademarks

The documents, text, software, scripts, graphics, photos, sounds, music, videos, interactive features, presentations, materials, trademarks, service marks, logos, the virtual and physical event look and feel, and all other contents made available in the course of the series, and the elements comprising the virtual and physical event, are the property of The Organizer, their partners, or the exhibitors. No license or other intellectual property right to such materials is granted to you. You may not copy, download, distribute, publish, reproduce, transmit, publicly perform, sell, sublicense, make available, or otherwise exploit any such materials. You may not use or alter the trademarks, service marks, logos, slogans or source identifier of either, the Organizer or the exhibitors, without the permission of the party owning such trademark, service mark, logo, slogan or source identifier.

You may also be exposed to submissions from other users. The Organizer is not liable to you for any other user's submission, and you agree to waive, any legal or equitable rights or remedies you have or may have against the Organizer and the exhibitors with respect to other user's submissions, to the full extent permitted by the applicable laws and ordinances.

The Organizer has the right to review user submitted content to determine whether it violates the Terms of Use, and to remove or alter that content without notice to you. However, even though we have the right to review and remove content, we do not routinely monitor the virtual or physical event for violations of these terms. Accordingly, you should have no expectation that any and all content made available has been reviewed or is compliant with these terms. Under these premises, you agree that neither The Organizer will be liable for any failure to remove or alter content.

Prohibited Activities

You are solely responsible for all electronic activities or engagements under your user account, and your physical conduct in face-to-face events. You are prohibited from, and agree not to:

- create false user accounts, use another individual's user account or otherwise access the virtual event in an unauthorized manner;
- copy, modify, reproduce, transmit, republish, distribute or create derivatives of any of the content, software or materials available in the event;

- launch any automated system, including, but not limited to, "robots", "spiders" or "offline readers" which access the event platform in a manner that sends more request messages to the platform in a given period of time than a human can reasonably produce in the same period of time by using a conventional on-line web browser;
- transmit material that contains malicious code, such as viruses, timebombs, cancelbots, worms, trojan horses, spyware, or other potentially harmful elements;
- use the communication systems made available to you during the event for commercial solicitation, unless expressly authorized to do so by the event sponsor, or intentionally omit, delete, forge or misrepresent transmission information, including headers, return mailing and internet protocol addresses;
- collect or harvest any personally identifiable information;
- make or submit any sexually explicit, racially, culturally or ethnically offensive, harmful, harassing, intimidating, threatening, hateful, discriminatory or abusive statements or content;
- impersonate any other person or entity or stalk or otherwise harass any other user or participant;
- make or submit any obscene, hateful or otherwise offensive material, comments or content;
- submit content which features pornographic, sexually explicit, describes or encourages dangerous or illegal acts, graphic or gratuitously violent content;
- invade another user's privacy or publish another user's personally identifiable information without such user's consent;
- violate the safe space of another user, whether online or physically during the event.

Suitcasing Policy

Please note that while meeting attendees are invited to the virtual and physical event, any and all attendees who are observed to be soliciting business at exhibitor booths, in education sessions, or the networking areas of the virtual, will be removed from the show, not allowed to return to the show, and no refunds will be made. Additional penalties may apply in accordance with the applicable laws and ordinances. The Organizer asks that both attendees and exhibitors report any violations they may observe to the Show Management immediately.

Third Party Websites

The virtual or physical event may contain or provide links to third party websites which are not owned or operated by The Organizer. Please consult such third-party websites for their policies. The Organizer does not have control over, endorse, or are liable to you for any third-party websites.

Indemnity

You agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Organizer, their contractors, service providers, agents and suppliers, and their respective officers, directors, employees, affiliates and agents, from and against any and all claims, damages, obligations, losses, liabilities, costs or debt, and expenses (including but not limited to attorney's fees) arising from your use of and access to the virtual or physical event, including your violation of the Terms of Use, any third party's intellectual property rights, damages arising out of your submissions or any other act or omission.

User Termination

The Organizer, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to terminate any user's access to the virtual or physical event for any violation of the Terms of Use, including repeat infringers, and to remove or take down any content posted in violation of the Terms of Use.

Data Privacy

The Organizer shall comply with the Data Privacy Laws in relation to the registration with the series of events, participation or attendance at the events, and use of the services provided, whether virtually or physically. The participants and users shall likewise be bound to comply with the data privacy provisions of the applicable laws and ordinances.

In accordance with the Data Privacy Laws, the Organizer shall adhere to the principles of accountability, identification of purpose, consent, limited collection, limited use, limited disclosure, limited retention, accuracy, safeguards, openness, individual access, and challenge to compliance.

Personal information shall be collected and processed to facilitate participation in the series of events, networking with exhibitors, and interaction with other participants. The Organizer may at its sole discretion transfer personal data to a processor, and under appropriate conditions and with security safeguards. The Organizer shall keep the personal information from the time of registration, throughout the series of events, and within a reasonable from termination of the series.

Concerns regarding data privacy shall be addressed by the participant to The Organizer. By registering with the series, the participant is deemed to have given consent to the collection, use and processing of relevant personal information for purposes of participation in the series.

General

You agree that the virtual and physical event shall be deemed passive, and solely based in the Philippines. The conduct of the series does not and will not subject the Organizer to foreign jurisdiction, or to litigation in any venue other than the Philippines. All claims or disputes shall be resolved in the Philippines. The Terms of Use shall be governed by the laws of the Philippines, without regard to its conflict of law principles and provisions. No waiver of any term of the Terms of Use shall be deemed made unless in writing, and no singular waiver shall be deemed a further or continuing waiver of such term or any other term. Any cause of action arising hereunder must commence within one calendar year of the date in which the cause of action first arose as condition precedent to such action, to the full extent permitted by the applicable laws or ordinances.
